These tours offer a great opportunity to join our Rangers on a guided tour of the many tracks and trails located within Northern Kosciuszko National Park.

Visit historic huts and homesteads, see and experience stunning views and ancient landscapes or explore this great national park to discover its unique flora and fauna.

Vehicle numbers are limited and some tours will require a four-wheel drive. Tours can be arranged to suit your special interests.

Huts, Heritage & Homesteads

If you have a passion for the past and wish to explore the pioneering heritage of the NSW High Country, why not book a huts, heritage and homesteads tour.

Join our Rangers and discover the history and the many challenges faced by people as they tried to make their living in the Snowy Mountains.

These tours can be arranged on site, as a Tag-A-Long or for small groups transport can be arranged for an additional cost.

Learn about our Environment

We have many activities available for children or adults that want to learn more about our natural environment, its landscapes, flora and fauna.

Through a fun and informative learning experience we focus on our native animals, plants and the high country habitats they live in.



Wiradjuri Wonders Cultural Tour

This tour is focused on experiencing all aspects of Aboriginal culture. Fun for all ages as you discover the secrets of the Australian bush and experience unique Aboriginal culture through a hands on learning experience. Taste and smell the treats of the bush, make your own artefact to take home.

Set in the unique bushland of the Snowy Mountains our Aboriginal Rangers will take you on a guided bush walk delivering a cultural experience you will always remember. Tours are available for either individuals or groups.

Bush Craft/Survival

For generations Aboriginal people have been one with the Australian bush through their strong connection with country and knowledge of Australian bush craft.

Learn the secrets of making traditional tools such as spears, stone axes, bush rope, coolamons, nula nulas, yabby traps, bush shelters and fire.

Discover how the bush can provide a range of foods and resources to help you survive by catching and finding indigenous foods.

Tours are available for individuals or groups and on request can be arranged for overnight camps however additional costs will apply.

Aboriginal Traditional Weaving

The difference between our weaving workshops is that not only do you learn the craft of weaving you learn how to source natural fibres from the Australian Bush.

Using natural bush fibres you will learn the art of weaving using reeds and bush rope to make a basket, a dilly bag or fish net that will be a unique craft item as individual as you are.

Half day to full day workshops can be arranged for individuals or small groups. For small group transport can be arranged for an additional cost.

Bush Tucker/Bush Plants

Australian bush tucker is becoming widely known for its culinary and medicinal qualities. Our bush tucker programs take participants on a journey of traditional cultural discovery as they learn the secrets of the bush through sight, touch and smell.

Enjoy the relaxing atmosphere of the bush as we stroll through searching for the treats it offers.

Guided Bush Walks

Kosciuszko National Park offers a range of incredible bush walks to experience that take you through a variety of stunning landscapes and mountain environments.

To enhance these unique experiences and gain an insight into these environments and the many facts and stories they hold we offer guided bush walks hosted by our Discovery Rangers.

From a short stroll to a day long walk there is a bush walk to suit all fitness levels and special interests you may have.
